You may find this sample language helpful:

Girl Scouts of Greater Mississippi is to receive the sum of [*specific amount*] or [*percentage*] percent of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate. This bequest is unrestricted, and the board or other governing body of Girl Scouts of Greater Mississippi may use and expend the bequest in any manner it deems appropriate.

You can also name Girl Scouts of Greater Mississippi as a full or partial beneficiary to a life insurance policy or retirement account. Please contact us to learn about other planned giving options.
